Paula Blackman is the library's newest part time faculty member and works as library liaison to the Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Bioscience and Physical Science departments.

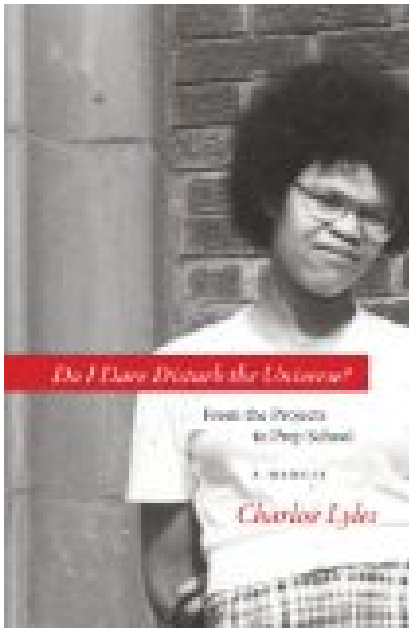

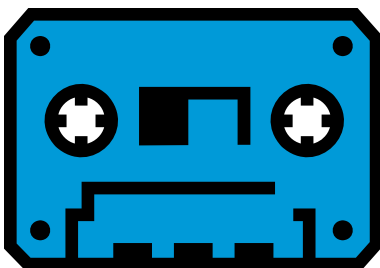

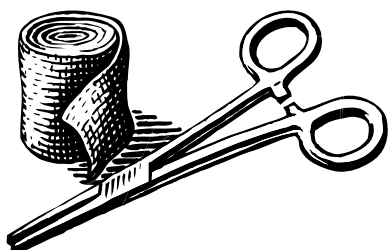
