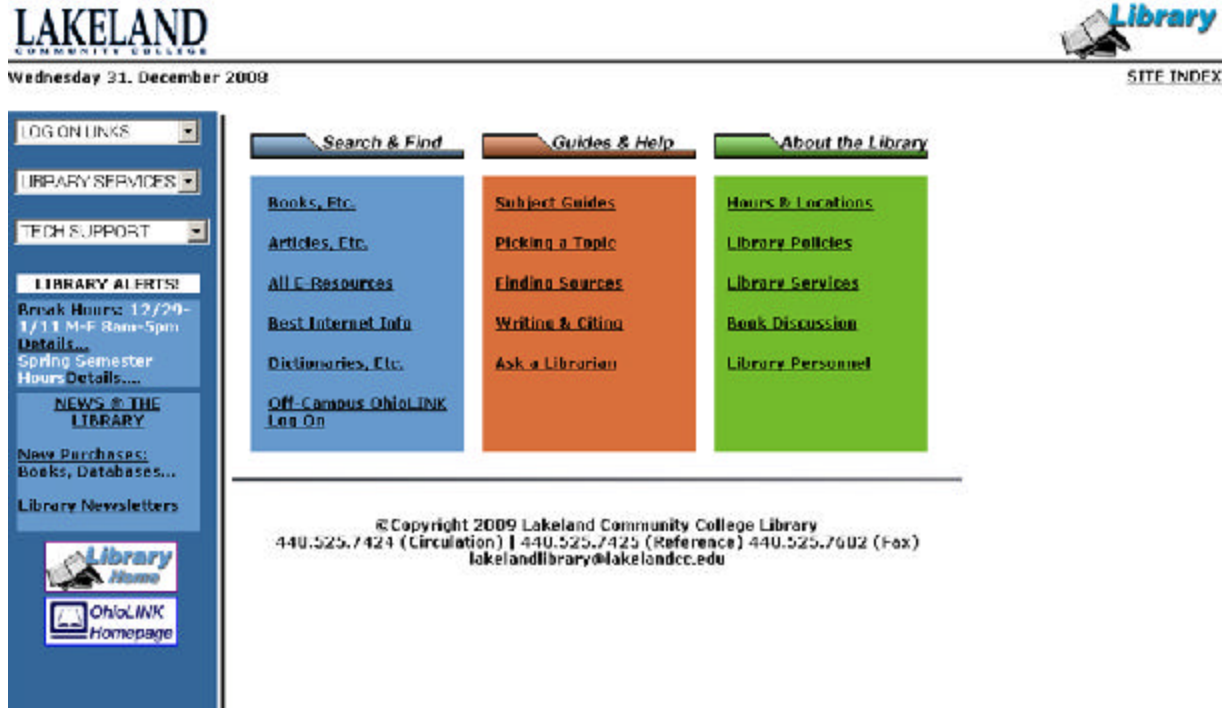


New Design for Library Website

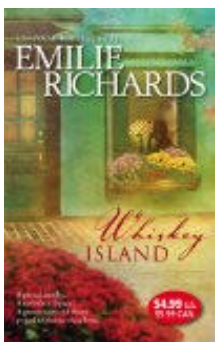

New Database: CQ Researcher Online

CQ Researcher is noted for its in-depth, unbiased coverage of health, social trends, criminal justice, international affairs, education, the environment, technology, and the economy.

CQ Researcher Online is designed to provide multiple points of access to *CQ Researcher* reports.

You may:

- Select from the current or recent reports on the **Home** page.
- **Find your topic in the section titled "In the News,"** which highlights earlier reports on topics that are once again in the headlines.
- Search by keyword, with the Quick Search on the **Home** page or use a number of delimiters in the **Advanced Search** page.
- **Browse by Topic**, which is similar to using the index at the back of a book.
- **Browse by Date** of publication, accessing reports from 1991 to the present.

If you are considering what topic to research or make the subject of a report, see the **Find a Topic** section.
